3. Based on Matthew 10:24-26, how do you think Jesus feels about risk? What do you think He would say is a mistake?

4. On Sunday Lee gave the example of David, who was small, couldn't wear the armor, and was discouraged by others, even his own family. Let's look at another example in Exodus 4:10-12.

a. This was not Moses' first protest when God called on him to go set the Israelites free. How did God answer his protests? See also Hebrews 13:21.

b. Go back to Exodus 4, this time reading verses 1-4. What did God ask Moses that is a review of the first week of our Opportunity Knocks series?

c. How do you think Moses' limitations ended up strengthening him?

5. Read Ephesians 5:15-17, focusing on verse 16. What are some examples of opportunities we can seize?
